Biographical / Historical

Jonathan Brace (1810-1877) graduated from Amherst College in 1831 and pursued theological studies in Andover, Massachusetts; New Haven, Connecticut; and Princeton, New Jersey. In 1844, after having served as pastor of the Congregational Church in Litchfield, Connecticut, for about eight years, he resigned from his post. By the following year, he had resumed his ministry at the First Congregational Church in Milford, Connecticut.

Brace was married to Sarah E. Brace (-1866), with whom he had a son, William Henry Brace (-1846).

Scope and Contents

Letters, journals, and sermons by or relating to Jonathan Brace, Congregationalist minister at First Congregational Church in Litchfield and Milford, Connecticut, 1785-1877. Some materials pertain to members of the Brace family, specifically Brace's mother, Lucy Mather Brace; his aunt, Fanny Brace; and his grandfather, Congressman Jonathan Brace (1754-1837).
