Biographical / Historical

Thomas Max Smith was born in New York on December 26, 1874. He received the A.B. from Yale in 1898, the same year as Charles Ives. He earned a law degree from Columbia and passed the New York bar, but never practiced. In 1909 he married Mary Hardy. They had no children. Smith studied music for many years, beginning at the age of eight; his teachers included Horatio Parker and Samuel Sanford at Yale. He served as a music editor and critic at the *New York Press* (1903-1916) and the *New York American* (1916-1919 and again in 1923). Thereafter he worked intermittently as a foreign music correspondent for the *New York Herald Tribune*. He died of a cerebral embolism on June 7, 1935.

Scope and Contents

The Max Smith Papers contain letters to and from Smith and family members, composers, performers, and critics. Arturo Toscanini is especially well represented; in particular, there are many telegrams and letters relating to Toscanini's decision to conduct the New York Philharmonic in 1926-1927, and also to the Philharmonic's European tour in 1930. The Papers also hold rough drafts and printed copies of articles by Smith. Smith's life and work are further documented by: programs; photographs; and miscellaneous materials.

Correspondence is organized in the following categories:

A. Letters to Max Smith, arranged in alphabetical order by the last name of the sender. Within each name, the letters are then placed in chronological order. Unidentified material is grouped together at the end of this section.

B. Letters to Arthur Toscanini, arranged as above.

C. Letters from Smith and Toscanini, arranged alphabetically by recipient. Also included in this section are letters to and from people other than Smith and Toscanini, arranged alphabetically by sender, and miscellaneous letters. Of special note is the collection of 14 copies of letters from Josef Giehl to his parents which he wrote while studying under Liszt in Rome, 1879-1880.

D. Telegrams mostly, and letters involved with getting Toscanini to conduct the New York Philharmonic during the 1926-1927 season. These are between (among) Toscanini, Smith, and Clarence McKay (business director for the orchestra), and are arranged chronologically from May 4, 1923 to Nov. 18, 1926. A second set of telegrams relates to the European tour of the New York Philharmonic under Toscanini, which occurred in 1930.

E. Communiques to Messrs. Merrill and Hearst from Smith, and their answers concerning his resignation from post as Music Critic for the American paper, arranged chronologically.
