Biographical / Historical

In 1825, a group of ministers of the Boston Baptist Association met at First Baptist Church of Boston and decided to found a Baptist seminary in the Boston area. The group raised the funds necessary to purchase and repair the 80-acre Peck estate in Newton, Massachusetts, and Irah Chase was appointed the first professor of biblical theology. Newton Theological Institution was incorporated by the Legislature on February 21, 1826, and the first classes were held November 28, 1826. The graduate seminary was formally affiliated with the group now known as American Baptist Churches USA, which is the oldest Baptist denomination in America. In 1931 Andover Theological Seminary moved to Newton Theological Institution's Newton Centre campus, and the two schools became affiliated, forming Andover Newton Theological School. In 1965, the two Schools formally merged. - 1825 ○ Newton Theological Institution founded in Newton Centre, Massachusetts
- 1826 ○ Newton Theological Institution incorporated by the Massachusetts Legislature
- 1931 ○ At invitation of Newton Theological Institution, Andover Theological Seminary relocates to Newton Center, Massachusetts
- 1965 ○ Newton Theological Institution and Andover Theological Seminary formally merge to form Andover Newton Theological School
