**SUMMARY:** The collection is comprised of manuscript volumes, manuscript and incunabula leaves and fragments, and bound and unbound partial volumes of manuscripts and printed books, dating from approximately 850-1955, collected by educator, collector, and dealer Otto F. Ege. The collection consists of religious texts, such as bibles, books of hours, prayer books, hymnals, missals, psalters, choir books, and well as histories and literature from Europe, Persia, and Asia. The collection also contains a small amount of material documenting the life and career of Otto F. Ege and to a lesser extent Louise Ege, including writings, correspondence, photographs, newspaper clippings, and catalogs or advertisements.

A few items were previously on deposit with the Beinecke Rare Book and Manuscript Library, before they were gifted to or purchased by the Beinecke in 2016.

### Processing Information

Description of materials in the Otto F. Ege collection was repurposed from description provided by the sellers and donors and notes shared by Scott Gwara. Additional description and information of items in the collection were provided by Hannelore Segers, Agnieszka Rec, and Lisa Fagan Davis. This finding aid will be amended as revisions to description are made by staff.

Collections are processed to a variety of levels, depending on the work necessary to make them usable, their perceived research value, the availability of staff, competing priorities, and whether or not further accruals are expected. The library attempts to provide a basic level of preservation and access for all collections, and does more extensive processing of higher priority collections as time and resources permit.

These materials have been arranged and described according to national and local standards. For more information, please refer to the Beinecke Archival Description Processing Manual.

Empty portfolios for Original Leaves from Famous Books (numbered 72, 76, 82, 83, 84, 89, 102) and Original leaves from Famous Bibles (unnumbered), duplicate published writings, and copied newspaper clippings were discarded.

## Biographical / Historical

Otto F. Ege (1888-1951) was an educator, collector of rare books and manuscripts and, most notably, a dealer, known for removing leaves from manuscript and print volumes for exhibition and sale. In the early 1920s he began to disassemble incomplete medieval manuscripts and incunabula and to sell the leaves, at first as single items but soon in a series of boxed portfolios intended to illustrate cultural subjects, including the history of the Bible and "Fifty Original Leaves from Medieval Manuscripts." Ege defended his book breaking on educational grounds, even authoring an article in 1938 titled "I am a Biblioclast."

Otto F. Ege was born in Reading, Pennsylvania, on April 14, 1888, to John Ege and Pauline Ege (nee Wonnberger). He graduated from Reading High School in 1907 and studied design and art education at the Philadelphia Museum School of Art and New York University. In 1920 he moved to Cleveland, Ohio, and began a long career at the Cleveland Institute of Art, holding several positions including instructor, department chair, and dean (1946-1951). He also taught at Western Reserve University (Case Western) and lectured across Ohio, New York, and Pennsylvania. His teaching included the use of book art specimens (or fragments). Ege was an advocate for the teaching and appreciation of Book Arts. He became a noted expert on medieval manuscripts and early modern printed books. He served as tour guide and buyer for several libraries and museums in Ohio. Ege became a renowned collector and dealer.

Scott Gwara, in his extensive study of Ege, characterizes Ege's collecting in three phases. Between 1911 and 1934, Ege collected broadly, building his personal and teaching collection. During this time, Ege sold manuscript fragments taken from damaged or incomplete volumes. Between circa 1935 and circa 1946, Ege established a rare manuscripts and books trade business and sold fragments (from incomplete and intact volumes) in presentation mats and portfolios to museums, libraries, and educational organizations as well as middle-income collectors. The portfolios were compiled to illustrate topics in book history, such as famous bibles, medieval manuscripts and history of type. From about 1947 until his death on June 17, 1951, Ege focused his collecting and business on compiling and selling Original Leaves from Famous Books, exceptional leaves matted and encased as a portfolio set. Ege died before the project was complete, and the compilation and sell of the portfolio was completed by Louise H. Ege (nee Lange), his widow.

Ege's legacy as educator, collector, and dealer is complex. He is recognized as a strong advocate for the education in and appreciation of book arts and for creating the market for affordable manuscript and incunabula fragments. He was also criticized for his practice of breaking or disassembling and dispersing (by sell) unique and rare volumes. Proclaiming himself a biblioclast in a 1938 article in *Avocations* he defended his book-breaking practices for allowing more people the opportunity to see, own, learn about, and appreciate the art in manuscripts, incunabula, and fine books. Many single leaves and fragments collected and sold by Ege are held in North American libraries, their study in digital form has been foundational to the development of digital fragmentology.

Otto F. Ege died on June 17, 1951. He was survived by his wife Lousie H. Ege (nee Lange) and their daughter Elizabeth (Betty). Louise and Betty stewarded Ege's collection, sold or donated parts to various institutions. Ege's grandchildren sold the remainder of the collection to Yale University in 2015.

## Scope and Contents

The collection is comprised of manuscript volumes, manuscript and incunabula leaves and fragments, and bound and unbound partial volumes of manuscripts and print volumes, dating from approximately 850-1955, collected by educator, collector, and dealer, Otto F. Ege. The collection consists of religious texts, such as bibles, books of hours, prayer books, hymnals, missals, psalters, choir books, and well as histories and literature from Europe, Persia, and Asia.

The collection also contains a small amount of material documenting the life and career of Otto F. Ege and to a lesser extent, Louise Ege, including writings, correspondence, photographs, newspaper clippings, and catalogs or advertisements. The collections does not include records documenting the financial side of Ege's career.

The Ege collection serves to illustrate a thousand years of book history, especially script and illumination, as well as components of the production (such as bindings) and trade of manuscripts and early books.

When known Ege titles and identifier and Cleveland Museum of Art and Gwara Handlist identifiers are included in the description.

## Collection Contents

The series consists of complete (or almost complete) manuscript volumes (circa 1150-circa 1826), primarily from Europe, that comprised Otto Ege's personal collection.

### Series III: Manuscript broken volumes and fragments, circa 850-1900

The series consists of broken, incomplete, and fragments of manuscripts volumes. Leaves from many, potentially all, of the volumes were included on Ege's portfolios and inventory intended for sale. A few volumes appear complete but are in poor condition.
