Barbara Guest, American author. Guest was born Barbara Pinson in Wilmington, North Carolina on September 6, 1920. She died on February 15, 2006 in Berkeley, California.

Scope and Contents

The Barbara Guest Papers span 1923 to 2006 and document Guest's life as a prominent American poet, her personal and professional relationships with other writers, and her personal life as a wife, mother, and friend. The papers include drafts of writings, correspondence, personal and professional papers, photographs, artwork, printed material, audiovisual material, born digital material, artwork, and a typewriter.

Series II: Writings, 1953–2004

This series contains writings by Guest and writings of others. Writings by Guest includes drafts of her poetry, prose, drama, essays, lectures, lectures and reviews, and her biography on *H.D. entitled Herself Defined: The Poet H.D. and Her World*; and notes on kept by her throughout her writing process. Writings by others includes drafts by others that were sent to Guest for critique or are on Guest herself, reviews of Guest's published work, or are interviews with Guest.

Organized into two subseries: Writings by Guest and Writings by others

Writings by Guest

Poetry contains drafts of Guest's poems. Notable poetry publications represented include *Bandusia*, *Blurred Edge*, *The Countess from Minneapolis*, *Defensive Rapture*, *Minatures and Other Poems*, *Poems*, and *Quilts*. Drafts grouped together by Guest and unsorted poetry drafts and related papers are filed at the end of the subseries.

Prose contains drafts of Guest's prose writings, including her novel, *Seeking Air*, and her prose poetry work, *Rocks on a Platter: Notes on Literature*.

Drama contains Guest's dramatic writings, including "The Execution of Mary Stewart", "The Lady's Choice" and "The Office".

Essays contains notebooks of essay drafts kept and titled by Guest, "Notebooks 1-8", and other essays, including essays on H.D. and other artists and writers.

Herself Defined: The Poet H. D. and Her World contains correspondence, research notes, photographs, and working drafts of Guest's notable biography on H.D.

Also in the subseries are various notes kept by Guest, lectures written and presented by Guest upon invitation, reviews by Guest on others' works, and drafts of Guest's bibliography.

Material in this subseries includes handwritten, typescript, and composite drafts. Enclosures are noted when present.

Organized into eight groupings: Poetry, Prose, Drama, Essays, *Herself Defined: The Poet H. D. and Her World*, Notes, Lectures by Guest, and Other writings.
