Processing Information

She graduated June 12, 1930 and two little snippets of blue and silver fabric from her graduation gown were saved. She graduated from Duluth Central High School, Duluth, Minnesota. Tucked in the book are her graduation announcement, the program from the commencement, the program from "Class Night," and the bulletin from the preceding Sunday from her church the First Methodist Church from a service dedicated to the new graduates. It seems a bit poignant. She filled out the page listing her gifts and her activities the day of graduation, but no friends or faculty signed and there were no clubs or dances or parties. An example of her entries: On June 8th she returned from the church service and wrote: "On returning home I found no one home so spent most of the day by myself except that I went down to Leif Ericcson [sic] Park in the afternoon and listened to the concert given by Duluth Central's High School Band. One of the numbers was "America." Everyone stood up and it was quite thrilling to see people standing all over the hillside and the band playing. In the evening I studied awhile for examinations, and then sat out in the porch swing with Mrs. Bendickson, one of Newell Bendickson's friends threw a ball through the window next door."
