# **Biographical / Historical**

Robert Adams (1937-) is an American photographer whose work focuses on the changing landscape of the American West. Adams was born in New Jersey to Ross Adams and Lois Hickman Adams. He received his

B.A. in English from Redlands University in 1959 and Ph.D. from University of Southern California in 1965. Adams married Kerstin Mornestam in 1960. He began taking photographs while teaching at Colorado College in 1963, and became a full-time photographer in 1970. Adams has published over 40 photography books and his photography has been exhibited at galleries and museums throughout the United States and abroad.

# Scope and Contents

The collection documents the life and career of American photographer Robert Adams, including photographs, correspondence, clippings, writings, posters, printed material, born digital material, and audiovisual material. Photographs include landscape photographs throughout the western United States, portraits, family photographs, and photographs of Adams's exhibitions at galleries and museums throughout the United States and abroad. Also present are posters for Adams's exhibitions, reviews of his books and exhibitions, some of his early writings, and his art, primarily drawings.
