Processing Information

Collections are processed to a variety of levels, depending on the work necessary to make them usable, their perceived research value, the availability of staff, competing priorities, and whether or not further accruals are expected. The library attempts to provide a basic level of preservation and access for all collections as they are acquired, and does more extensive processing of higher priority collections as time and resources permit.

This collection received a basic level of processing, including rehousing and minimal organization.

Information included in the Description of Papers note and Collection Contents section is drawn from information supplied with the collection and from an initial survey of the contents. Folder titles appearing in the contents list below are often based on those provided by the creator or previous custodian. Titles have not been verified against the contents of the folders in all cases. Otherwise, folder titles are supplied by staff during initial processing.

Besmilr Brigham (1913-2000)

Besmilr Brigham was an American poet and author. She was born Bess Miller Moore in Pace, Mississippi on September 28, 1913 and raised in the Rio Grande Valley region in Texas, later adopting the phonetic spelling of her name: "Besmilr." Her maternal grandfather was a member of the Choctaw Nation. She graduated from the University of Mary Hardin-Baylor in Belton, Texas, and studied writing at The New School in New York City.

While Brigham was a prolific writer throughout her career, she was most active in the late 1960s and 1970s, publishing her work under the all-lowercase name "besmilr brigham." During this period, she published two books of poetry, *Agony Dance: death of the (Dancing dolls)* (1969) and *Heaved from the Earth* (1972). Her work was collected posthumously in *Run through Rock: Selected Short Poems of Besmilr Brigham* (2000), edited by poet C. D. Wright. She first began publishing her work in 1966 with the submission of the long poem *Yaqui Deer* to Mexican bilingual quarterly *El Corno Emplumado*. Her later poems were published in anthologies such as *31 New American Poets* (1969) and *Rising Tides: 20th Century American Women Poets* (1973), and periodicals including *The Atlantic*, *Harper's Bazaar*, and *The New York Times*, as well as Thomas Merton's literary magazine *Monks Pond*. Her work was recognized with a National Endowment for the Arts

Discovery Award grant in 1970. Brigham also wrote short stories; "The Lottery Drawing" was featured in *The Southern Review* (1982) and *Mississippi Writers: Reflections of Childhood and Youth* (1985).

Brigham married newspaperman Roy Brigham, with whom she had one daughter, Heloise. From 1950 to the mid-1970s, the family traveled frequently throughout Mexico and Central America, Canada, and Alaska. She lived much of her later life in Arkansas. She died in Las Cruces, New Mexico on September 30, 2000.

Content Description

The Besmilr Brigham papers consists of correspondence, writings, notes and drawings, printed material, personal papers, and audiovisual media documenting the life and work of poet Besmilr Brigham. Materials date from 1931 to 2011, with the bulk dating between 1960 and 1990. The collection contains correspondence with Robert Bly, Robert Duncan, Charles Glicksberg, Richard Howard, James Laughlin, Denise Levertov, and Margaret Randall, among other literary figures, and family correspondence. Writings consist mainly of annotated typescript drafts of poetry, short fiction, and novels. Notes and drawings include research on Indigenous cultures, class notes, travel journal entries, and early poetry and prose by Brigham. Printed materials consist of clippings and scrapbooks used as source material for Brigham's stories, as well as catalogs, pamphlets, flyers, and maps. Personal papers include biographies, fellowship and grant applications, records of publication and reviews of Brigham's work, teaching materials, and files on events and programs involving Brigham, such as C. D. Wright's *Lost Roads Project*. Audiovisual media consists of cassette and open reel tapes of readings, interviews, performance art, and recordings related to an unproduced lyric drama by Brigham, "Games for an Easter Child," and religious ceremonies of Pascua Yaqui Indians.

Collection Contents

Series I: Correspondence, 1942-2011

15.5 linear feet (38 boxes)

This series contains Brigham's professional correspondence with editors, publishers, and other literary figures, including Robert Bly, Robert Duncan, Charles Glicksberg, Richard Howard, James Laughlin, Denise Levertov, and Margaret Randall, concerning submissions and publication of her work, poetry readings, grant applications, and teaching projects, although the bulk of the series consists of family correspondence. There is some correspondence with Judith Jones of Knopf, editor of Brigham's poetry collection *Heaved from the Earth*, and with Dorothy Abbott, editor of the anthology *Mississippi Writers: Reflections of Childhood and Youth*, which featured poetry and fiction by Brigham. The series additionally contains a large amount of correspondence between Brigham and Forrest Coggan, director of Teatro Internacional and founder of the American Mythic Theatre program, regarding a planned production of her dance lyric drama "Games for an Easter Child."

Correspondence can also be found in Series II. Writings, and Series V. Professional and Personal Papers.

Organized into three subseries: Incoming Letters, Outgoing Letters, and Family Correspondence

Incoming Letters

This subseries contains letters to Brigham from editors and publishers, as well as other writers, friends, and associates from California, Mexico, and Central America.

There is also a file of autobiographical essays and letters, dated 1972-1991, referencing her childhood, travels in Europe, the United States, Mexico, and Central America, inspirations for her writing, and background of her Choctaw grandfather, Elisha Emmons, which she researched in Choctaw Nation records during a trip to Oklahoma.

Family Correspondence

This subseries contains extensive correspondence between Besmilr and Roy Brigham and their daughter and son-in-law Heloise and Keith Wilson regarding personal and financial matters, Besmilr's writings, submission and publication of her work, and her relationships with editors and other literary figures. They also discuss the Brighams' life and travels in California, Mexico and Central America, the American Southwest, and Arkansas, and attendance at various ceremonies and celebrations of the Yaqui, Apache, and other Indigenous peoples. Some letters between Besmilr and Keith, also a poet, include her thoughts on the technical aspects of writing and advice about his career. The series additionally contains correspondence with Brigham's parents, Bessie and Monroe Moore, grandchildren, in-laws and other family members, and a small amount of unrelated correspondence and papers of the Moore and Wilson families

Organized into three groupings: Letters from Besmilr and Roy Brigham to Heloise and Keith Wilson, Letters from Heloise and Keith Wilson to Besmilr and Roy Brigham, and Other family correspondence and papers.

Letters from Besmilr and Roy Brigham to Heloise and Keith Wilson

Includes letters written by the Brighams while they lived in San Francisco and Berkeley, California, Arkansas, Arizona, and Texas, and during their trips to Mexico and Central America from the 1950s through the 1970s. Many letters contain updates on Besmilr's writings and revisions she made, submissions and rejections of her work, and efforts to generate income through poetry readings or teaching positions, as well as Roy's jobs as a typesetter. Other topics include books, films, readings at the San Francisco Poetry Center and The Cellar, the Brighams' travel experiences, and contemporary social and political issues, such as student unrest, racism, and the Vietnam War. Letters sometimes were enclosed with copies of Brigham's poems, essays, and other writings.

This series consists primarily of drafts of poems, short stories, novels, and novellas by Brigham (majority unpublished), and a small amount of printed materials. Most of the drafts are typescripts with corrections in Brigham's hand. The series contains extensive records documenting submission and publication of *Heaved from the Earth* by Knopf, including multiple poem drafts, page proofs, editorial correspondence, contracts, royalty statements, and reviews. There is also a significant amount of material for the dance lyric drama "Games for an Easter Child," including drafts, correspondence, and notes and drawings based on Brigham's research of Pascua Yaqui traditions and observation of ceremonies in Arizona and Mexico. Other works by Brigham represented in the series are her first published poem, *Yaqui Deer*, and poetry anthology *Agony Dance: death of the (Dancing dolls)*, as well as poems and stories published in journals such as *New Directions*, *The North American Review*, *The Southern Review*, and *Southwest Review*. Like *Agony Dance*, titles of Brigham's works often incorporate open-ended parentheses and other non-traditional punctuation. In addition, the series contains novel drafts by Brigham's husband Roy, and writings of others.

Writings can also be found in Series I. Correspondence, and Series III. Notes and Drawings.

Organized into six subseries: Poetry, Shorter Works, Novels and Novellas, Writings by Roy Brigham, Printed Materials, and Writings of Others.
