Koster, R. M. (1934-)

Richard Morton Koster, an American author, journalist, and educator, was born on March 1, 1934 in Brooklyn, New York. In the late 1950s, he graduated from Yale University with a degree in English. Koster is best known for the *Tinieblas Trilogy: The Prince* (1972), a finalist for the 1973 National Book Award in Fiction; *The Dissertation* (1975); and *Mandragon* (1979). Other notable works include *Carmichael's Dog* (1992), *The Glass Mountain* (2001), and *In the Time of the Tyrants: Panama: 1968-1990* (1991), a history of the military rule of Panama written with journalist Guillermo Sánchez Borbón. Koster moved to Panama in 1957. He taught English at the Panama Canal campus of Florida State University from 1964 to 2001 and has contributed articles to publications including *Newsweek* and *The New York Times*. Koster was also involved in American politics, serving on the Democratic National Committee from 1967 to 1996 and authoring presidential debate copy for Senator John Kerry in 2004.

Scope and Contents

The collection contains writings, newspaper clippings, papers relating to Panamanian politics, and ephemera documenting the career of American author R. M. Koster. Writings include typescript drafts, proofs, and galley proofs of Koster's published and unpublished works. Notable works included are *Carmichael's Dog*, *The Dissertation*, *Glass Mountain*, *Mandragon*, *The Prince*, and *In the Time of Tyrants: Panama: 1968-1990*, written with journalist Guillermo Sánchez Borbón. Panamanian political material includes memorandums, treaties, reports, and affidavits.

Organized into three series: I. Writings, 1950-2000. II. Panama Political Material, 1972-1989. III. Printed Material, 1975-1990.
