Also included are genealogical charts linking the Dickins family to Pocahontas through her marriage to John

Rolfe, and twentieth century documents concerning family history.

Processing Information

Biographical / Historical

The Dickins family lived in Oxfordshire and Warwickshire, England, and included Rachel Dickins (-1761) of Suffolk; Thomas Eden Dickins (1832-1857), 2nd Lieutenant of Artillery in the East India Company; Colonel Francis E.A. Dickins (1827-1912), a merchant in India; Reverend Charles Dickins (1829-1917); William Dickins (1795-1885), a barrister; and W.P. Dickins (active 1899).

Scope and Contents

The Dickins Family Papers contains correspondence, writings, legal documents, and other papers relating to Rachel Dickins, Thomas Eden Dickins, and other members of the Dickins family, as well as diaries, poetry, and a collection of fifteenth through seventeenth century charters with seals. Other materials in the collection relate to James Bean, an assistant paymaster with the East India Company in the Philippines in 1764, Captain William Wilkinson, a financial agent to Sir George Hay, and Wallace of Craigie, a descendant of William Wallace. Also included are genealogical charts linking the Dickins family to Pocahontas through her marriage to John Rolfe, and twentieth century documents concerning family history.

Arrangement

Organized into three series: I. Correspondence, 1795-1928 and undated. II. Charters and Legal Documents, circa 1449-1670. III. Other Papers, 1725-2000 and undated.

Collection Contents

Series I: Correspondence, 1795-1928 and undated

0.75 linear feet (2 boxes)

This series contains correspondence between members of the Dickins family, the Ellis family, and others, including Thomas Hay of Mordington and Captain William Wilkinson. Included are letters from Francis Atherton Dickins to his wife, Emily Elwes Dickins, during a six-month tour of Kashmir, India, as a trader with the East India Company, letters to Lucy Park Dickins from her father, J.A. Park and her husband, solicitor William Dickins; and letters concerning financial transactions, especially loans, between Thomas Hay and Captain William Wilkinson.

Organized into three subseries: Dickins Family, Ellis Family, and Other Correspondence. Materials within each grouping maintain the order found at the time of acquisition.

This series contains English, Welsh, and Scottish charters, indentures, and exemplifications, mostly relating to property. Documents are chiefly written in Latin on vellum and affixed with wax seals of varying sizes.

Series III: Other Papers, 1725-2000 and undated

1.25 linear feet (3 boxes)

This series primarily contains twentieth century materials related to family history, such as correspondence, legal documents, printed materials, transcriptions, and dealer inventories, as well as eighteenth and nineteenth century writings, including poetry, diaries, and the last will and testament of Rachel Dickins. Genealogical charts and family seats track the history of the Dickins family and connect them to Pocahontas (Matoaka) through her marriage to John Rolfe. Printed materials include brochures and pamphlets describing Dickins family property, including the houses in Chastleton and Cherington, as well as a history of the Craigie family.

Materials maintain the order found at the time of acquisition.
