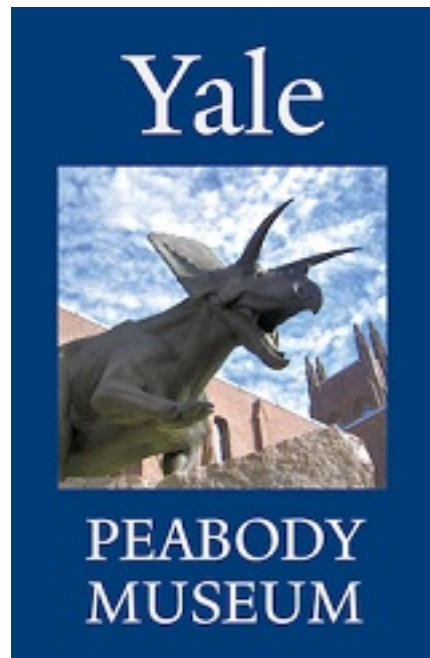

**SUMMARY:** This electronic archive contains documentation supporting the research collection of items assembled between 1986 and 2018 by Leedom Lefferts and Louise Allison Cort. Their research focused on increasing an understanding of present-day earthenware and stoneware ceramic production in Mainland Southeast Asia. The archive consists of written, visual, and material documentation of a structured series of field trips to the region, covering 207 sites. It also includes the results of briefer research conducted during trips taken to the region for other purposes, documentary research in libraries and online, and contacts with colleagues. The electronic archive is supported by the physical copies of the same notebooks, slides, videotapes, and files of paper documents.

## Biographical / Historical

Hill. Louise Allison Cort (1944-) is a craft historian. Her B. Litt. thesis for Oxford University treated the 700-year history of a Japanese stoneware ceramic-producing community. Cort has also researched and published on the community of temple-servant potters in Puri, Odisha, India. She is Curator Emerita of ceramics at the National Museum of Asian Art of the Smithsonian Institution (Freer Gallery of Art and Arthur M. Sackler Gallery), where she curated large collections of both historical and contemporary ceramics in Southeast Asia.
