## Biographical / Historical

Yale Divinity Library traces its origins to the construction of the Sterling Divinity Quadrangle in 1932. At that time, three separate collections\* were moved from the original Divinity Quadrangle at the corner of College and Elm Streets to 409 Prospect Street. Rooms to house the Trowbridge Reference Library\* and the Day Missions Library\* were constructed within the 1932 library, and those spaces have been preserved through two major renovations (1982 and 2003). The Sneath Library of Religious Education\* was merged into the general Divinity Library collection. Since 1974, the library has developed and sustained an active Special Collections department. Following the library's 2003 adaptive re-use renovation, the former Paul

A. Vieth Resource Center materials and staff were assimilated into the Divinity Library as the Ministry Resource Center. A large portion of Divinity's printed and archival material now resides at the Yale Library Shelving Facility under environmentally secure conditions, and may be requested by readers for use at the Divinity Library.

## Scope and Contents

The records document the development and growth of the Library of the Yale Divinity School, one of the foremost theological libraries in the world. The historical material dates from the 19th century, though the bulk is from the 20th century to present day. Included are the files and annual reports of Divinity Librarians Raymond Morris, Stephen L. Peterson and Paul F. Stuehrenberg. The international activities of the library are evident in grant funded projects that document, preserve and improve access to specific collections. Library departmental files from Technical Services and Special Collections show how the Yale Divinity Library has evolved over time through the implementation of technology to aid access, acquisitions, cataloging and description. Finally, publications and photographs, provide visual evidence of changes, developments and renovations of the library as it preserves the past and looks to the future.
