The aim of the Ecumenical Leaders Index Project, an endeavor funded by the Episcopal Church Foundation, was to create a database of information regarding individuals, issues, and events connected with the ecumenical movement during the time period 1935-1960. Project staff surveyed all relevant manuscript and archival collections at the Yale Divinity Library to discover correspondence and papers of the individuals selected for inclusion in the Index. Database entry printouts provide biographical information for the ecumenical leaders and listings of available archival resources related to them.

Mission Studies Resource Development Project

The Mission Studies Resource Development Project began in 1993 and over the next 18 months investigated the international base of research resources for mission studies and the study of world Christianity. It was sponsored by a grant from The Pew Charitable Trusts. Stephen L. Peterson, Director of the Trinity College Library, was the project director. Project staff included Jonathan J. Bonk, Project Associate (Providence College and Seminary, Otterburne, Manitoba, Canada) and Joan Duffy, Research Assistant (Yale Divinity Library).

This collection contains documentation related to the investigations undertaken by the Mission Studies Resource Development Project. The Project employed three primary methods to garner information: mailed questionnaires, site visits, and consultations. Different questionnaires were constructed to be used with different populations: mission agencies, overseas church bodies, libraries, archives, and individuals.
