Andrew J. Russell (1829-1902) was an American photographer, known for his photographs of the American Civil War and as official photographer of the Union Pacific Railway in Wyoming and Utah. He published the Union Pacific photographs in several publications including the *Union Pacific Railroad Views*.

The photographs were commissioned by the Union Pacific Railroad Company and taken by Andrew J. Russell between 1864 and 1869.
