Eleanor Clark (1913-1996)

Eleanor Clark was the author of critically acclaimed novels and non-fictional works from the mid 1940s to mid 1980s, as well as short fiction, essays, poems, and plays. Novels included *Bitter Box* (1946), *Baldur's Gate* (1970), *Gloria Mundi* (1979), and *Camping Out* (1986). Non-fictional works included the travel narratives *Rome and a Villa* (1952) and *Oysters of Locmariaquer* (1965), which won the National Book Award, and the memoir *Eyes, Etc.* (1977).

Eleanor Clark was born July 6, 1913, in Los Angeles, California, raised in Roxbury, Connecticut, and educated at Vassar. She worked as a freelance writer, editor, and translator in the mid 1930s and as an editor for W.W. Norton & Company in New York from 1936 to 1939. Clark married Robert Penn Warren on December 7, 1952.

Scope and Contents

The Eleanor Clark Papers consists of writings, correspondence, and personal papers documenting the life and work of the writer Eleanor Clark. Writings include work spanning over fifty years, from short stories and poems written and published while Clark was a undergraduate at Vassar in the early 1930s to the late fiction and non-fiction of the 1980s. The writings feature notes, drafts, proofs, and printed materials relating to Clark's published works of fiction and non-fiction, from drafts of what would become *Baldur's Gate*, dating from the mid 1930s, to drafts of her last novel, *Camping Out* (1986). In addition, there are drafts and printed versions of numerous published and unpublished shorter works, including short stories, essays, poems, plays, speeches, readings, and book reviews.

Correspondence in the collection consists chiefly of incoming letters from family, friends, writers, editors and publishers, and educational and cultural institutions. Larger correspondence files may be found for Clark's husband, Robert Penn Warren, her mother, her two children, Gabriel and Rosanna Warren, and Louis MacNeice, Katherine Anne Porter, and Muriel Rukeyser, among others. Other noteworthy correspondents include authors W.H. Auden, Saul Bellow, Hermann Broch, Albert Camus, John Cheever, Robert Fitzgerald, Elsa Morante, Eudora Welty, Glenway Wescott, and Thornton Wilder. There are also files of correspondence, including fan mail and letters from publishers, relating to published works.

Other materials include college papers, journals, and notebooks.

The collection is organized into five series: I. Writings, 1915-1993. II. Correspondence, 1876-1988. III. Personal Papers, 1881-1988. IV. October 2013 acquisition, 1876-1988. V. May 2022 acquisition, 1881-1996.

Collection Contents

Series I: Writings, 1915-1993

The Writings of Eleanor Clark, housed in boxes 1-25, is subdivided for Novels, Non-Fiction, and Shorter Works, and arranged alphabetically by title within each subdivision. The writings feature notes, drafts, proofs, and printed materials relating to Clark's published works of fiction and non-fiction. There are, for example, drafts of what would become *Baldur's Gate*, dating from the mid 1930s, to drafts of her last novel, *Camping Out*, dating to 1986. In addition, there are drafts and printed versions of numerous published and unpublished shorter works, including short stories, essays, poems, plays, speeches, readings, and book reviews. Drafts for short stories published in the collection *Dr. Heart* are filed alphabetically in Shorter Works, whereas drafts for the collection, published by Pantheon Books in 1974, are filed in Novels. The titles to most shorter works are listed in quotes and printed versions are noted only when present; supplied titles are bracketed.

Correspondence files relating to several of Clark's books have been preserved in Series II. Correspondence.

The Writings of Others, housed in boxes 26-27, is arranged alphabetically and features drafts of poems and shorter works by John Pierrepont and Ethel P. Rice.

Series II: Correspondence, 1876-1988*5 linear feet (12 boxes)*

General Correspondence, housed in boxes 27-37 and arranged alphabetically by correspondent, consists chiefly of incoming letters from family, friends, writers, editors and publishers, and educational and cultural institutions. Larger correspondence files may be found for Clark's husband, Robert Penn Warren, her mother and children, Louis MacNeice, Katherine Anne Porter, and Muriel Rukeyser, among others. Other noteworthy correspondents include authors W.H. Auden, Saul Bellow, Hermann Broch, Albert Camus, John Cheever, Robert Fitzgerald, Elsa Morante, Eudora Welty, Glenway Wescott, and Thornton Wilder.

General Correspondence also includes original outgoing letters from Clark to family members. Clark's letters to family members, including large files to her mother, Eleanor Phelps Clark, and daughter, Rosanna Warren, are foldered separately from incoming letters. Carbons of outgoing correspondence to others are documented in folder notes.

Third Party Correspondence, housed in box 37 and arranged alphabetically by recipient, consists of all loose third party correspondence in the collection, and includes several letters between family members. Other third party letters probably came into Clark's possession as enclosures and, over time, were separated from the original letters.

Files of correspondence relating to published works by Clark have been preserved in the subseries Correspondence Relating to Writings. These files, housed in box 38 and arranged alphabetically by title, consist chiefly of fan mail and letters from publishers. Letters from writers and correspondents found in the General Correspondence subseries are documented in folder notes. References ("see also" notes) are provided from General Correspondence where appropriate.

The May 2022 acquisition includes additional writings, correspondence, photographs, personal and family papers relating to Eleanor Clark. Writings consist chiefly of drafts and printed versions of shorter works, as well as a few pieces relating to *Rome and a villa* and *The Oysters of Locmariaquer*. The bulk of the general correspondence consists of incoming letters to Clark dating from the early to mid 1990s. There are also a small number of outgoing letters from Clark to her mother, Eleanor Phelps Clark, and her husband, Robert Penn Warren, dating from the 1930s and 1950s respectively. Photographs include snapshots of Clark, Robert Penn Warren and family, as well as older studio portraits of members of the Phelps family, specifically, Clark's mother, her maternal grandfather, Charles Henry Phelps, and her maternal great grandfather, Charles William Phelps. Other papers include a bibliography of Clark's published work, biographical information, certificates, contracts, financial, legal, medical, and school records, notebooks, a passport, and printed materials.

In addition to Clark's papers, there is a clutch of material dating from the late 1920s through early 1930s pertaining to a school proposed by Clark's mother, Eleanor Phelps Clark, for the education of young women. Identified on one document as the "Clark school for girls," instruction would be provided in French and English, and the school located strategically in the quiet of the countryside, in Westchester county, but in proximity to the "opportunities in music, art, and drama" available in the city. Materials include correspondence, drawings, financial records, planning documents, and property surveys.
