Processing Information

This collection received a basic level of processing, including rehousing and in some instances minimal organization.

The finding aid for this collection is compiled from a preliminary list that was created at or around the time of receipt by the library. The preliminary list was migrated to comply with current archival descriptive standards. As part of the migration, modifications were made to the formatting of the list; however, the content of the list was neither modified nor verified.

Folder titles appearing in the contents list below are often based on those provided by the creator or previous custodian. Michael De Lisio (1911-2003)

Michael De Lisio (1911-2003), American poet and sculptor. Born on January 22, 1911 in New York City. De Lisio published poetry in *Scribner's* and *The New Yorker*, the latter where he also worked in the office. He served with the navy during the second World War. De Lisio began creating artwork after a two-

decade career in public relations for MGM. He exhibited at the Nova Scotia College of Art in Halifax (1969), Minneapolis Institute of Arts (1971), the Brooke Alexander Gallery (1978), the Princeton University Library, Smith College Museum of Art (1974 and 1980), and Boston College (1998). He died in New York City on January 21, 2003.

Irving Drutman (1910-1978)

Irving Drutman (1910-1978), American journalist, editor, songwriter, and collector. Born Isidore Druitman to Max Druitman, an upholsterer, and Esther Druitman on July 28, 1910. Drutman wrote articles for the *New York Herald Tribune* and *New York Times*. In addition to theatrical journalism, Drutman's involvement in theatre and film also included working as a freelance publicist and songwriting, with songs including "Twilight Song," "Mama Never Told Me," and "Bel Ami." Drutman edited Janet Flanner's memoirs *Paris Was Yesterday* (1972) and *London Was Yesterday* (1975), and collected writings *Janet Flanner's World* (1979). Drutman published his memoir *Good Company* in 1976. He died of cancer on September 20, 1978 in New York City.
