This collection received a basic level of processing, including rehousing and in some instances minimal organization. Each acquisition is described separately in the contents list below, identified by a unique call number and titled according to month and year of acquisition.

George Van Santvoord (1891-1975)

George Van Santvoord was born in Bennington, Vermont on 5 August, 1891 and educated at Hotchkiss School, Yale University (1912), and Oxford University. After serving with the American Field Service and 39th U.S. Infantry, Van Santvoord taught English at Yale (1919-1921) and at the University of Buffalo (1922-1925). Van Santvoord then returned to Hotchkiss School, a preparatory school in Lakeville, Connecticut, to serve as Headmaster, a post he held from 1926 to 1955. Upon his retirement, he served in the Vermont legislature for ten years. Van Santvoord died in Williamstown, Massachusetts on 19 Februrary 1975.

Scope and Contents
