Additions to this collection will consist of only materials printed or written in the French language, and pertaining to French life and culture. No items or portions of collections will be transferred from individual collections to this collection.

Arrangement

The papers are arranged in four sections: volumes, correspondence and loose papers, miscellaneous, and oversized. All items that are not listed individually in this register--and this is the vast majority of the papers in the collection--are filed as "correspondence and loose papers in boxes 7-8. Most items are cataloged individually in the manuscript catalog, the union catalog, and the inventory catalog.
