George Burbank Shattuck was born in Lowell, Massachusetts in 1869. He taught geology at John Hopkins University from 1897 to 1905 and at Vassar College from 1906 until his death in 1934. Shattuck also traveled extensively as a photographer for anthropological expeditions to locations including Africa, Central America, and the American West.
