Francis William Crandall was born on January 13, 1889, in Westfield, New York. He graduated from Yale University in 1911. After working in the lumber industry in the state of Washington, he relocated to Pittsburgh during the Depression. Crandall was a banker until his retirement in 1952. He died in 1959.
