SUMMARY: The papers consist of a diary kept by McCarthy during his year of service with the 6th Imperial Bushmen cavalry unit in the Boer War, 1900-1901; legal documents, including birth and marriage certificates; limited correspondence; photographs; records kept by McCarthy during his tenure as a sergeant with the New South Wales police, 1901-1922; a collection of McCarthy's bush poetry; and newspaper clippings collected by McCarthy.

Alfred Stephen McCarthy was born September 8, 1878, in Mudgee, New South Wales, Australia. From 1900-1901, he served in South Africa with the 6th Imperial Bushmen of the Imperial Bushmen's Contingent, an Australian cavalry unit. Following this period of service, he returned to New South Wales where he worked as a local police sergeant.
