LANGUAGE: The materials are in English and German.

SUMMARY: The papers consist chiefly of notes, manuscripts, documents, minutes of parliamentary committees, pamphlets and other materials collected by Hajo Holborn in connection with research on the drafting of the Weimar constitution. The pamphlets include works on related subjects, such as the German revolution of 1918, the Workers' and Soldiers' Councils, constitutional history and federalism in Germany, territorial questions concerning Silesia and the Saar, and materials on German political parties, including minutes of meetings, leaflets and printed matter from the Deutsche Demokratische Partei (DDP). Some of the DDP material is particularly addressed to women. Also in the papers are essays and reviews by Holborn, teaching materials from his tenure at the Hochschule für Politik in Berlin and Yale University. There is only a small amount of correspondence, largely on professional matters. Important correspondents are Friedrich Meinecke and Alfred Vagts, who also contributed a memoir on Holborn.

Biographical / Historical

Hajo Holborn was educated in Germany. From 1926-1931 he was a professor of history at the University of Heidelberg. Holborn was the Carnegie Professor of History and International Relations at the School of Politics in Berlin from 1931-1934. He was a professor of history at Yale University from 1934-1969.

Scope and Contents

The papers of Hajo Holborn came to Manuscripts and Archives from the History Department of Yale University in September 1969, several months after Holborn's death in June of that year. They are made up of the contents of his office files and contain few letters and personal documents. (A preliminary inventory was prepared by Professor Hans Gatzke of the Yale University History Department in 1971 and was the only guide to the papers until this register was completed in 1981.) Other records have unfortunately disappeared. Although the papers do not cover the full range of Holborn's interests, they offer a remarkably coherent reflection of his activities ca. 1920-1935.

The papers have been divided into two series: OFFICE FILES and SUBJECT FILES. The OFFICE FILES contain surviving correspondence, negotiations with various universities and publishers, and drafts and reprints of several essays and reviews, offprints sent him by colleagues, and memorabilia. Through the kindness of Alfred Vagts, we have electrostatic copies of twelve letters from Holborn to Vagts concerning his emigration to the United States and his later academic career (1934-1941). Together with these is a brief memoir on Holborn by Vagts, probably written ca. 1976.

The SUBJECT FILES consist very largely of printed matter arranged topically. The major portion of this material was gathered in connection with a commission received by Holborn in 1929 from the Historische Reichskommission to write a history of the constitution of the Weimar Republic. (See Box 1, folder 4.) The materials on this topic which constitute a major part of the papers are made up of Holborn's own handwritten and typed notes, pamphlets, periodicals, handbills, typescript copies of documents, and other papers. Most vivid in charting the writing of the constitution are the large number of working papers issued by the Constitutional Assembly (Die verfassunggebende deutsche Nationalversammlung) which were originally in the possession of Dr. Marie Baum, a member of the Assembly and of the Deutsche Demokratische Partei (DDP). A letter from Hugo Preuss (then Staatssekretär des Innern) transmitting the first official draft (1919 Jan 7) of the constitution and a memorandum of explanation contains extensive comment on the draft in an unidentified hand. (Box 12, folder 95.) Many other stages of the constitution are included in the papers, as are counter drafts by interest groups and petitions from industry, labor organizations, local communities, the elderly, small landholders, etc. seeking to influence the decisions of the Assembly. Rare records on the origins of the DDP, also from Dr. Baum, contain handbills and election pamphlets dealing with the role of women within the party, pamphlets issued by the party discussing issues of the day, and proceedings of some of its meetings in 1919. Also of importance are the pamphlets on the Workers' and Soldiers' Councils of 1918-1919, including a rare copy of *Allgemeiner Kongress der Arbeiter und Soldatenräte Deutschlands vom 16.-21. Dec. 1918. Stenographische Berichte*, as well as contemporary reports by and about councils in Bavaria, Berlin, and Hamburg.

The bulk of the series is made up of pamphlets and books issued between 1919 and 1929. Many were published by small presses in small editions and are now difficult to find. Of those that survived, many were printed on cheap paper and are in poor condition. There are also some 19th century pamphlets on early attempts at a constitution for Germany and discussions of the constitutional question. A bibliography, probably drawn up by Holborn in connection with this project (Box 19, folder 170), has been annotated by Manuscripts and Archives staff to indicate which pamphlets are in the collection and to note their location. Taken together, the combination of printed matter, documents, and clippings provides a rich resource for the study of the beginnings of the German Democratic Party, the Revolution of 1918-1919, the Workers' and Soldiers' Councils, as well as the constitutional foundation of the Weimar Republic.

Nine books which were seriously damaged in a flood at Manuscripts and Archives in 1980 had to be discarded. These are listed at the end of the register. Fortunately duplicate copies of these books are in the stacks of Sterling Memorial Library and are available to the reader.

In order to preserve the printed matter in the collection and also make it more accessible, the books and pamphlets have been filmed and are available on MICROFILM HM 118. An author and subject guide provides access to the reels.

The papers consist primarily of correspondence to and from Hajo Holborn. Correspondents of note include Theodore Heuss, who served as the first President of the Federal Republic of Germany following the Second World War from 1949 to 1959; German historian Friedrich Meinecke; and pioneering electronic music composer, Werner Kaegi. Also included are writings by Holborn; a newspaper clipping; a copy of remarks delivered at a meeting of the Yale history department on the occasion of Holborn's death; and an essay about Holborn written by Dietrich Gerhard.

Correspondence is arranged by writer and chiefly concerns Holborn's research on the Weimar constitution. Of particular interest is a letter (1930 Feb 2) from Friedrich Meinecke. Also in this section is business correspondence with the German universities where Holborn taught. Electrostatic copies of twelve letters (1934-1941) from Holborn to Alfred Vagts, together with a memoir by Vagts on Holborn, were contributed by Alfred Vagts in 1977. The letters document his emigration to the United States and the beginnings of his career here.

Speeches contains the text of several speeches, ca. 1930.

Teaching is arranged by institution and contains teaching materials from the Deutsche Hochschule für Politik and Yale University.

Writings is arranged chronologically and contains manuscript and typescript drafts as well as printed versions of articles and reviews by Holborn. Also included is some correspondence with publishers.

Memorabilia contains a variety of miscellaneous material, including a carbon copy of the will of Holborn's father, Ludwig Holborn.

Not all of the Holborn papers listed in this register have been filmed. The items omitted are Hajo Holborn's academic papers and printed matter and memoranda not related to the Weimar period.

SUBJECT FILES, which consist almost entirely of pamphlets and printed documents, are arranged alphabetically by subject. Certain important figures for whom we have material (either by or about) have also been listed directly under their names: e.g. Friedrich Meinecke, Friedrich Naumann, and Hugo Preuss. The large number of documents issued by the National Assembly in 1919 are grouped together under the official name of the assembly: Die verfassunggebende deutsche Nationalversammlung. Non-governmental pamphlets on the constitution—its history, legal aspects, controversy over it, etc.—are grouped under the heading "Weimar constitution." An index to the pamphlets is at the end of the register.

Since the books and pamphlets are in poor condition, they have been filmed both to preserve them and for the convenience of the user. The reader interested in using only the pamphlets should use the microfilm. See MICROFILM HM 118. There is a subject and author guide to the reels.
