Administrative Information

Immediate Source of Acquisition

The Yale Bookplate Collection was formerly housed in Sterling Memorial Library. The collection was incorporated into the Arts of the Book Collection in 1984 and then moved to the Seeley G. Mudd Library in 1990. In 2011, it was transferred to the Robert B. Haas Family Arts Library.

Processing Information

The collection was removed from filing cabinets which housed bookplates by individual artists. Some materials included in this collection indicate the provenance of the following bookplate collectors or collections: Edith M. Baker, Frank S. Hatch, William Fowler and Ada M. Hopson, and Irene D. Andrews Pace.

Biographical / Historical

Timothy Cole (1852-1931) was an American wood engraver. In addition to designing bookplates, Cole had a long career working in magazine illustration, notably with *The Century*, and creating printed reproductions of European paintings.

Scope and Contents

The collection includes bookplates designed by Timothy Cole for both individual and institutional patrons.

Arrangement

Organized into three series: I. Bookplates – Individuals, 1915-1930. II. Bookplates – Institutions, 1908-1926. III. Ephemera, undated.
