Biographical / Historical

Nathaniel Hurd (1730-1777) was born in Boston and learned the metalsmithing trade from his father, Jacob Hurd. In addition to silversmith, he was an accomplished engraver and heraldic artist, producing numerous armorial bookplates in addition to other commercial printing.
