Biographical / Historical

Born Irene Greene Dwen, Mrs. Pace (1892-1962) was an avid bookplate collector from the early 1920s until 1962. In addition to over 150,000 plates in her collection, she also maintained a reference library related to bookplates, as well as heraldry and biographical research. Pace commissioned several hundred bookplates for herself. In 1936, she published *Owners of Books: The Dissipations of a Collector*.

Scope and Contents

The collection consists of early American bookplates commissioned by both individuals and institutions, as well as correspondence and ephemera related to the collection.

Arrangement

Organized into four series: I. Bookplates - Individuals. II. Bookplates - Organizations, Institutions, and Businesses. III. Bookplates - Unidentified. IV. Correspondence and Ephemera. Within each series, bookplates are arranged alphabetically. Any correspondence or ephemeral materials relating to a specific bookplate are filed together with the bookplate.
