Biographical / Historical

Nathan Todd Porter, Jr. (1867-1947) was a dry goods commission merchant born in Brooklyn, NY. He graduated from Yale, Class of 1890. He worked for Porter Brothers & Co., located in New York, NY, and lived in Montclair, NJ. He married Caroline Chester Knickerbocker in 1892; they had two daughters: Helen and Caroline. He was also a member of the University Club and a trustee of the Montclair Free Public Library.

Edwin Davis French (1851-1906) was a designer and engraver born in North Attleboro, MA. In 1876 he moved to New York, NY, and he worked as a silver engraver and designer for Frank M. Whiting & Company until 1894. He also studied at the Art Students League. French became focused on copper engraving and designed his first bookplate in 1893. In 1897 he moved to Saranac Lake, NY, and he produced over 300 bookplate designs between 1893 and his death in 1906.

Scope and Contents

The collection comprises close to 200 bookplates designed by Edwin Davis French, which were collected by Nathan T. Porter, Jr. In addition to bookplates, the collection also contains another example of engraved illustration by French, namely a small reproduction of Jean-François Millet's *The Sower*, which was used as the imprimatur of author and publisher William Loring Andrews.

Arrangement

Organized into four series: I. Bookplates – Mounted. II. Bookplates – Unmounted. III. Other Engravings. IV. Ephemera.

Collection Contents

Series I: Bookplates – Mounted

This series contains bookplates mounted on gray paper mounts, measuring 10 x 8 inches. The mounts are printed on recto with "No. _____" in the upper right corner and with "Collection of | Nathan T. Porter, Jr. | Montclair, N. J." in the lower left corner. The bookplate mounts are hand-numbered in black ink.

The bookplates are arranged in numerical order by their identification numbers from a published checklist of French's bookplates and other engravings, *Edwin Davis French: A Memorial; His Life, His Art*, by Ira Hutchinson Brainerd (1908). According to Brainerd, the checklist "follows [French's] notation with the little continuation needed to carry it to completion." This arrangement is roughly chronological, although some earlier bookplates have been appended to the end of Brainerd's checklist (see Box 2, Folder 10).
