Harry Dwight Dillon Ripley (1908-1973) was an English artist and patron of the arts associated with the New York School and the Tibor de Nagy Gallery. His life partner was Rupert Charles Barneby (1911-2000), an English botanist responsible for describing over eleven hundred new species of plants.
