## Processing Information

The library attempts to provide a basic level of preservation and access for all collections, and does more extensive processing of higher priority collections as time and resources permit.

This finding aid was produced in 2014 from information supplied with the collection, including Charles Joseph Levy's list of the collection contents and original folder titles. Titles have not been verified against the contents of the folders in all cases. Otherwise, folder titles are supplied by staff during basic processing. Additional changes were made in 2022 to make the description compatible with current systems.

## Scope and Contents

The Charles Joseph Levy Collection of Victoriana contains printed material, including clippings, advertisements, and pictorial works; other ephemera, including objects; and a small amount of manuscript material, nearly all dating from the reign of Queen Victoria (1837-1901).

## Arrangement

Organized into four groups: I. Ephemera; II. Ephemera - Addenda; III. Material Not Listed by Levy; IV. Objects.

The collection is arranged in the order in which it was received. The descriptive categories and item descriptions are taken almost entirely from the original inventory by Charles Joseph Levy; no attempt has been made to standardize the language or style of the entries.
