SUMMARY: Collection includes: official seals of the United States, Canadian provinces, and the British Empire, primarily on letters from government officials laid into five scrapbooks; several magazines and an atlas of Canada; chart of Scottish clans and coats of arms; wax seals of Jersey (Channel Islands), Guernsey (Channel Islands), and Gambia Colony; collections of letters and autographs of literary, historical and church figures; zoology notebooks kept by Cameron while a student at West Virginia University; manuscript by Cameron entitled "The Channel Islands."

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Kenneth Walter Cameron, born in 1908, received his B.A. and M.A. degrees from West Virginia University in 1930 and 1931, an S.T.B. from General Theological Seminary, New York, in 1935, and his Ph.D. from Yale in 1940. He was ordained an Episcopal priest in 1935, and taught English at the University of North Carolina, Temple University and Trinity College. Cameron also served as archivist and historiographer of the Diocese of Connecticut.

Scope and Contents

The Kenneth Walter Cameron Collection consists of letters, documents and governmental seals collected by Cameron, as well as writings by Cameron himself. The collection is arranged into four series. [Series I, Collection of Seals](#) (1860-1947), consists of materials collected by Cameron for government and other seals, including five scrapbooks of autograph letters from United States and British government officials, three solid wax seals, several magazines and an atlas of Canada. [Series II, Autograph Collection of Church Figures](#) (1916-1939), contains Cameron's collection of manuscript, typewritten and printed documents and letters signed by clergy of the American, Anglican and Eastern Churches. [Series III, Collection of Historic Documents](#) (1753-1939), contains a collection of letters and documents signed by literary and historical figures of the 18th through 20th centuries. [Series IV, Personal Papers](#) (1927-1932), contains material written by Cameron. [Oversize](#) contains material from Series I and III.
