SUMMARY: Collection contains correspondence, writings, and other papers documenting the life and work of Solange Clésinger-Sand. Correspondence consists of letters to and from Clésinger-Sand and third-party letters between family and others. Notable correspondents include the following friends, family, and family friends: Édouard Bourdet, Alphonse Guérin, Amélie Grille de Beuzelin, Maurice Sand, Charles Poncy, Samuel Rocheblave, and Jules Troubat. Writings by Clésinger-Sand include complete manuscripts for the early "Les roses et une fauvette..." (1834), "Histoires pour les toute petits," and a travelogue entitled "Une visite à Charon", in addition to a number of drafts for incomplete projects, including a play ("Sélim"), a theatrical adaptation of the novel L'Uscoque by George Sand, and a novel ("Thora"). Other materials include artwork, clippings, financial and legal records, notebooks, photographs, and papers relating to property ("Villa Malgrétout") purchased by Clésinger-Sand. Photographs include portraits of Clésinger-Sand, her husband, sculptor Jean Baptiste Clésinger, and others.

Solange Clésinger-Sand (1828-1899)

Solange Clésinger-Sand, daughter of prolific 19th century French author George Sand and Casimir Dudevant. Studied piano with Frédéric Chopin during Chopin's summer sojourns at the Sand estate in Nohant from the late 1830s to mid 1840s. Married sculptor Jean-Baptiste (Auguste) Clésinger in 1847. Author of two published novels, *Jacques Bruneau* (1870) and *Carl Robert* (1887). Samuel Rocheblave, biographer of George Sand, compiled the correspondence between Solange and her mother as *George Sand et sa fille d'après leur correspondance inédite* (1905).

Scope and Contents

The Solange Clésinger-Sand papers contain correspondence, writings, and other papers. Correspondence consists of letters to and from Solange Clésinger-Sand and third-party letters between family members and others. Notable correspondents with Clésinger-Sand include the following friends, family, and family friends: Nazli and Wacyf Azmy, Édouard Bourdet, General Cantilli, Alphonse Guérin, Amélie Grille de Beuzelin, Maurice Sand, Charles Poncy, Samuel Rocheblave, and Jules Troubat. Writings include complete manuscripts for the early "Les roses et une fauvette..." (1834), "Histoires pour les tout petits," and a travelogue entitled "Une visite à Charon", in addition to a number of drafts for incomplete projects, including the play "Sélim," a theatrical adaptation of *L'Uscoque*, a novel by George Sand, entitled "Orion Soranzo," and a novel, [On Thora]. Writings also include manuscript notes and fragments. Other materials include artwork, clippings, financial and legal records, notebooks, photographs, and papers relating to a property in Cannes, named Villa Malgrétout, purchased by Clésinger-Sand in 1869. Photographs include portraits of Clésinger-Sand, Alfieri di Sostegno, Jean-Baptiste (Auguste) Clésinger, Charles Poncy, and Fernand de Préaulx.

Organized into three series: I. Correspondence, 1849-1899. II. Writings, 1834-1862. III. Other Material, 1852-1952.

Series I: Correspondence, 1849-1899

Series I, Correspondence, contains letters to and from Solange Clésinger-Sand and third-party correspondence. Notable correspondents with Clésinger-Sand include the following friends, family, and family friends: Nazli and Wacyf Azmy, Édouard Bourdet, General Cantilli, Alphonse Guérin, Amélie Grille de Beuzelin, Maurice Sand, Charles Poncy, Samuel Rocheblave, and Jules Troubat. In addition, copies of correspondence between Clésinger-Sand and philosopher Pierre Lanfrey can be found in Series II. Writings, "Declaration perdue!" Outgoing letters from Clésinger-Sand to others are mentioned in folder notes.

Third-Party Correspondence consists chiefly of letters between family members and others.

Writings also contain notes and manuscript fragments.

Series III, Other Material, contains artwork, clippings, financial and legal records, notebooks, photographs, and papers relating to a property in Cannes purchased by Clésinger-Sand in 1869.

Photographs include studio portraits, with carte-de-visites and cabinet cards, and images of artwork and interiors of the Sand estate in Nohant, France. Portraits include Solange Clésinger-Sand, Alfieri di Sostegno, Jean-Baptiste (Auguste) Clésinger, Charles Poncy, Fernand de Préaulx, and others. Other photographs include an image of Auguste Clésinger's celebrated "Femme piquée par un serpent" [Woman bitten by a serpent] (1847) housed at the Musée d'Orsay.

Material relating to Villa Malgrétout, named after the novel (*Malgrétout*) by her mother, consists of correspondence, plans, and financial and legal documents.
